

# INVESTMENT MIX AND INVESTMENT RETURNS FOR WITH PROFITS POLICIES

### Former Scottish Life Fund

This leaflet shows the 2018-2022 investment mix and investment returns for with profits (excluding Deposit Administration) policies that were formerly invested in the Scottish Life Fund. There is a separate leaflet for Scottish Life with profits policies that have always been invested in the RL open fund within the Royal London Long Term Fund.

The Scottish Life Fund was merged into the Royal London open fund with effect from 31st December 2021. This means that the investment mix and investment performance after then is that of the Royal London open fund.
