

## INVESTMENT MIX AND INVESTMENT RETURNS FOR WITH PROFITS POLICIES

### Royal London (CIS) Sub-Fund

This leaflet shows the 2013-2017 investment mix and investment returns for with profits policies in the Royal London (CIS) Sub-Fund.

Some of the information in this leaflet relates to periods before Royal London acquired Royal London (CIS) Limited on 31 July 2013.

The investment mix and investment return of policies varies by category of with profits policy.

Each category has its own investments which generate a separate investment return for the policies within it.

Option 32 Traditional With Profits policies are invested entirely in government bonds, other bonds and cash. This is because the policy guarantees are so far above the policy values, these policies effectively behave more like non profit policies.
